Regulation and Conditions of Entry including parking
ALL MOTOR SPORTS CAN BE DANGEROUS

**Please read these Regulations and Conditions of Entry carefully and co-operate fully.
By signing this form you have AGREED to our Rules and Safety Conditions.**

- 1 Drivers - please be aware you are responsible for the safety and behaviour of your passengers while you are on this site.
- 2 Drivers - ensure that you have informed your Motor Insurance Company that you participate in driving off road at pay and play days or your vehicle may not be insured while on site.
- 3 Maximum speed **10mph**.
- 4 All routes optional. White routes for novices. Rest of site red - see reverse for definition.
- 5 Comply with all written instructions and Marshall/ Organisers instructions.
- 6 Seat belts must be worn at all times (ALL persons in vehicle). Correctly fitted.
- 7 Drive safely and responsibly.
- 8 Soft top or open top vehicles - white routes only. Unless fitted with an approval roll cage. Helmets for all occupants.
- 9 Disclose on entry any known medical condition which could be effected by driving off road, or could affect your driver ability.
- 10 All drivers must hold Full UK Driving Licence.
- 11 Spectators - please contain children with you at all times, be aware of vehicles while walking on site.
- 12 If visibility is restricted please check route before driving.
- 13 Be prepared to meet oncoming vehicles at all times.

Recommendations

- 1 We recommend that you carry a Fire Extinguisher of correct type and in working condition.
- 2 You have a recovery point fitted to your vehicle (if in doubt please ask at Central Control)
- 3 If you are unsure of any aspect of off roading, please ask at Central Control, you will be introduced to the organiser and advised accordingly.

Accident Procedures

If you require urgent assistance sound horn in regular rhythmic pattern and call on CB Channel 30. All accidents must be reported to the organiser and recorded by our Safety Officer immediately.

ROUTE DEFINITIONS

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ THIS BEFORE DRIVING
SEAT BELTS - ALL VEHICLE OCCUPANTS

WHITE ROUTES - MARKED WITH WHITE ARROWS

Suitable for novice drivers in standard 4x4 vehicles with road tyres.

RED ROUTES - REST OF SITE

Experienced drivers only.

Risk to occupants.

Can be damaging to vehicles.

Off road tyres only.

Vehicles must have suitable recovery points (towbar etc).

Hard top or approved roll cage only.

It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that the vehicle they are driving is in a reasonable and safe condition.

Crash helmets advised in all vehicles. Loan helmets available at booking in.
